How to live together?


By leaving a valuable object unattended but always within the range of vision, the project invites visitors to explore their very own relation to the human surrounding.

A person showing its loneliness? Or an art project? Both appear possible. Intuition or rationality? Intuition draws people passing by towards the person. Rationality keeps them at a distance. Evaluating becomes necessary. The more the situation approaches the art world (Vernissage / Art-Fairs / etc.), the more the concept of art seems to influence the decision. The concept begins to interfere. It becomes relevant and its form makes itself noticeable for the visitor.

Buttons on the back of the speaker are out of order.



Every button increases the volume of the speaker.

The inauguration speech of Donald Trump from January 20, 2017 can be heard.

At the beginning at low volume. All buttons on the back of the speaker had been modified. Regardless which button the pedestrians press, they only increase the volume of the speaker. Louder/quieter, on/off, program up/down ... whether you argue for or against Trump, support or ignore him:

He is getting incredibly noisy. The more attention it requires to shut him off, the more attention he gets from all the others. In our midst. A loud, interactive interaction. With the result, that a populist, just like in the course of an election campaign, gains power through all of us.

And the question arises: How do we deal with it now? A (loud) speaker which can't be turned off.

At the beginning it is agreed that both persons may end the interaction with a simple step out of the rectangle.





How does my body answer these questions?

How does a resignated life feel like? Is there a certain form of relaxation by surrendering to the world? Relaxation which turns into dissatisfaction some day? Discontentment about myself? A feeling of "Did I miss a chance?" and "Could I have done more?"

The project tries to make two facets of powerlessness physically perceptible: On the one hand feeling comfortable because of being protected and on the other hand feeling uncomfortable by being evaporated, restricted.


Visitors find a picture of themselves with a handwritten note of a stranger explaining what impact their portrait had on his or her self-definition.



Peter Reisch | Born in Munich (Germany) on the 10th December 1982. Austrian citizen

A moment of irritation, a sudden disruption of the well-known – with his projects the artist Peter Reischl employs performative elements to challenge the ordinary. Provoking a reaction is a crucial part of Reischl's work, which addresses political and social topics by translating them into performative questions. His work is about creating a space of ambiguity, that doesn't lead to an answer or predefine a certain direction. That is what makes his art a provocative one: Like an experimental set-up, he merely arranges the basic parameters in order to trigger any re-actions of his counterpart. The spectator becomes the one in control. Reischls art projects provoke unfiltered reactions that aren't necessarily required in the course of everyday life. In a way, it's all about a re-activation of thinking, a re-discovery of one's agency and free will.
